The automation specialist will be offering virtual tours, accompanying online seminars or customer meetings in a planned "Grenzebach Studio". The Grenzebach World is open all year round. 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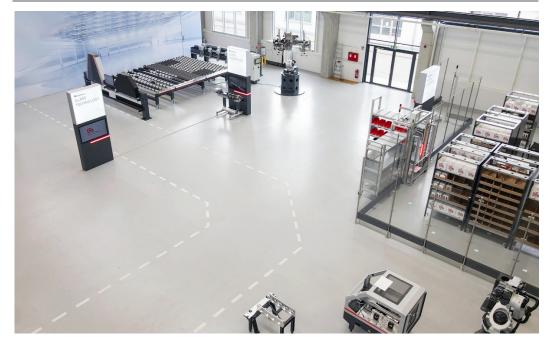
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conditions for continuous, lifelong learning, training and collaboration for their partners and employees.
